


# COL Davis Opening Remarks SFAB – 2030 / 2040



**ACM-SFAB** 

SFABs advise, support, liaison, and assess to support the development of capacity and capability of foreign security forces and their supporting institutions.



- SFABs are conducting advisory missions across multiple combatant commands.
- SFABs are fielded for conflict but operates primarily in competition.
- SFABs seek to maximize their capabilities across competition, crisis, and conflict.

How can Industry assist the SFAB with inoperability between combined, joint and partnered forces across each continuum?

- Mission Command: Enhance Line-of-Sight and Beyond-Line-of-Sight Communications
- Mission Command: Enhanced situational awareness
- Protection: Airspace Defense


