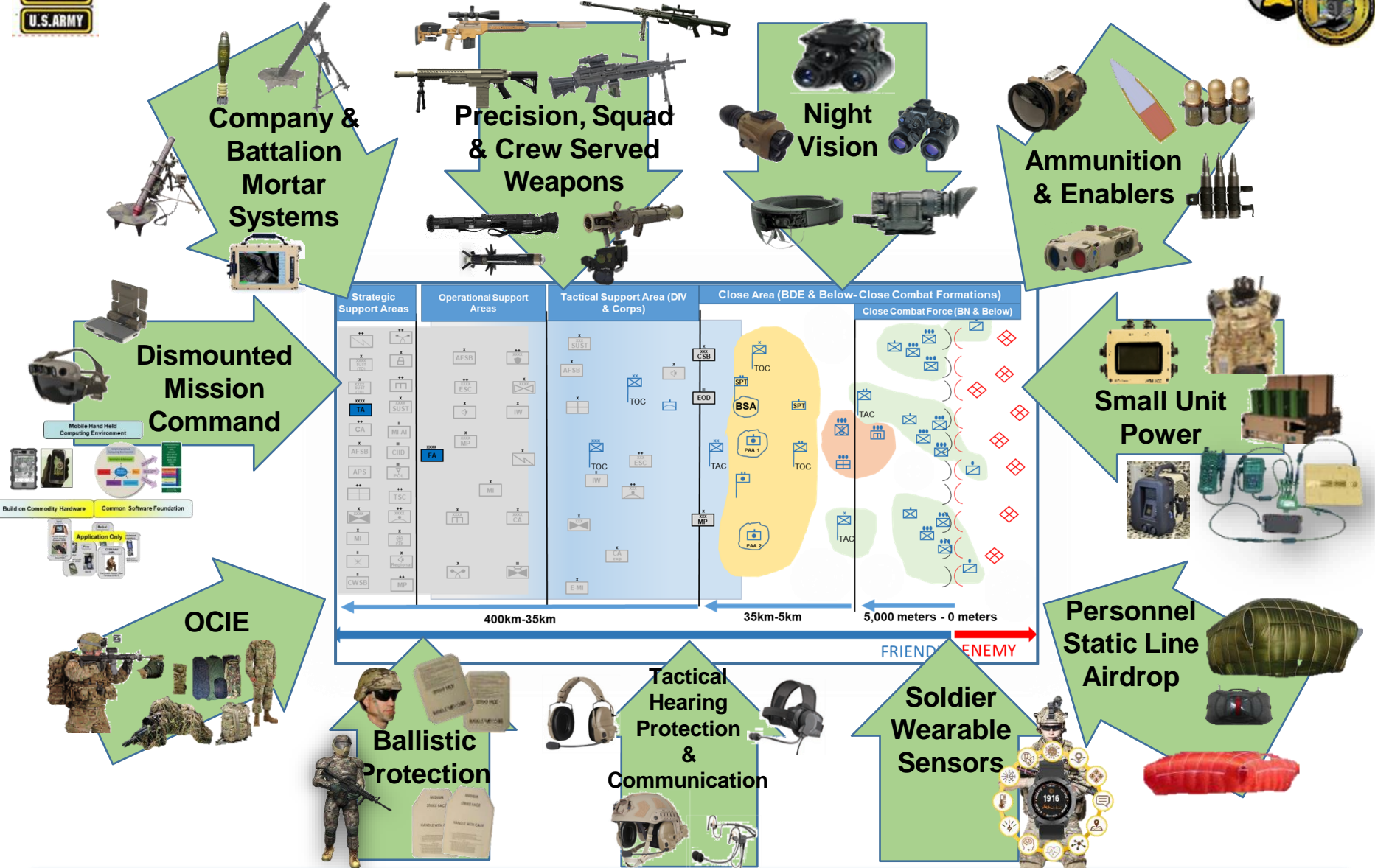


SRD is responsible for the development, integration, legacy updates and management of 400+ Programs

Enhancing the Combat Effectiveness of Soldiers

SEP is a congressionally mandated program established by the FY1990 National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA)

Uses a "Buy / Try / Decide" Methodology

Informs Requirements and provides PMs with technical and/or operational user feedback to improve capabilities and increase combat effectiveness

Meets a capability gap identified by Soldiers

Leverages COTS, GOTS, NDI to improve the combat effectiveness of Infantry Soldiers

Does **NOT** fund lengthy developmental programs or procure large numbers of major items for issue
