

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APPLICATION GUIDELINES

The Association of the United States Army (AUSA) is a nonprofit educational and professional development association serving America's Total Army, its Soldiers, Army civilians, and their families; industry partners, and supporters of a strong national defense. AUSA provides a voice for the Army, supports the Soldier, and honors those who have served in advancing the security of the nation.

AUSA's Chattahoochee Valley – Fort Benning Chapter is proud to present scholarships to graduating high school seniors and current college students enrolled in the 2025-2026 academic year. In 2026, the Chapter will be awarding at least \$17,000 in scholarships.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must meet the following eligibility requirements:

- Be a current member of AUSA's Chattahoochee Valley – Fort Benning Chapter.

- Have a 2.5+ cumulative grade point average, or equivalent, on a 4-point scale
- Be accepted by or enrolled as an undergraduate student into an accredited college or university at the time the scholarship is awarded

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Applicants must submit:

- AUSA's Chattahoochee Valley – Fort Benning Chapter Scholarship Application (**Page 3**)
- Transcript:
 - High School Transcript **with ACT or SAT** score (current high school students **ONLY**) **OR**
 - College Transcript (current college students)
- Resume. Please include dates and position(s) held. College applicants – do **not** include high school activities. Do not include any identifying information on any page of the resume.
 - Work History
 - Extracurricular Activities (Includes sports, music, drama, clubs and/or organizations, etc.)
 - Honors and Awards
 - Community Activities (Includes community service/volunteering, etc.)
- Short essay on the topic located on Page 3. The essay must be 500 words or less, in your own words, thoughts or opinions. You may research the subject, but do not include direct quotes or references. Do not include any identifying information on the essay.

- ALL APPLICATIONS MUST BE POST MARKED BY APRIL 15, 2026 -

SUBMISSION PROCESS

Scholarship applications must be submitted by mail. Incomplete applications will not be considered. Applications must be postmarked by **April 15, 2026**. SCHOLARSHIP AWARDEES


Scholarship awardees will be notified by mail by June 1, 2026.

Upon notification, each Awardee will be asked to provide additional information regarding the college or university they plan to attend in the fall semester. Each awardee must also sign a Multi-Media Consent Agreement. Once the information is received and verified, a check will be made out to the Awardee's educational institution. If an Awardee declines to provide the requested information, AUSA reserves the right to award the scholarship to an alternate applicant.

SCHOLARSHIP PRESENTATION:

Awardees will be invited to attend a general membership meeting of the Chattahoochee Valley – Fort Benning Chapter on June 14, 2026. Awards will be presented by both Fort Benning and AUSA Chapter leadership. Awardees will be notified of the time and location.
